

Organizational Regulations for the National Taiwan Normal University Student Club Review Committee

1. The Organizational Regulations for the National Taiwan Normal University Student Club Review Committee (the “Regulations”) are promulgated in accordance with Article 4 of the Regulations Governing the Guidance for Student Clubs at National Taiwan Normal University.
2. The Student Club Review Committee (the “Committee”) is established by the Office of Student Affairs for the purpose of reviewing and adjudicating disputes related to student clubs.
3. The Committee shall consist of the Vice President for Student Affairs, Associate Vice President of Student Affairs, Director of the Division of Extracurricular Activities, one faculty representative from each college, the chairpersons of each Student Club Committee and one representative from the Students’ Union. Appointed by the Office of Student Affairs, the Committee members shall serve a term of one year. Chaired by the Vice President for Student Affairs, the Committee may be convened in the case of student club disputes.
4. More than half of the Committee members shall be present before a meeting can convene, and resolutions shall only be effective with the consent of more than half of the attendees.
5. The Regulations and any amendments thereto become effective after approval by the Student Affairs Office Meeting and ratification by the Vice President for Student Affairs.
